

## **Investigator: Investigations/Sexual Offender Management Bureau - Mid-Hudson Valley**

The Office of the New York State Attorney General is seeking qualified candidates for Investigator positions located in various locations in New York State. Candidates should be hard-working, motivated and committed to public service on behalf of the people of the State of New York.

Investigators, under supervision, conduct detailed investigations of the circumstances, facts and conditions connected with complaints and violations of the law, using the highest level of independent judgement and discretion. These are often highly complex and sensitive criminal matters which cross county lines and involve organized crime.

SOMB conducts civil litigation necessary to either commit dangerous sex offenders to institutions, or to enable New York State to manage those offenders under supervision who are not in custody. In furtherance of that litigation, SOMB is routinely called upon to conduct detailed investigations into the underlying facts of an offender's crimes and into the offender's entire history. **The qualifications for this position are: Possession of a Bachelor's degree in criminal justice; experience holding the rank of Lieutenant or the equivalent; at least two years of experience dealing with sexual offenders and interviewing victims of sexual abuse, both adults and children; experience executing search warrants and testifying in court; experience acting as lead Investigator in homicide investigations; experience conducting narcotics investigations; and having law enforcement contacts in the Mid-Hudson area.**

### **Qualifications in addition to those listed above:**

Must have at least ten years of law enforcement and current NYS basic police school certification.

Must have the ability to drive a vehicle and possess a valid NYS driver's license.

The Public Officer's Law requires that police officers at the OAG be citizens of the United States and reside in New York State.

Performance of the duties may require frequent, unscheduled work on evenings and weekends.
