

## **Detective Investigator: Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU) – New York City**

The Office of the Attorney General is seeking qualified candidates for Detective Investigator positions located in New York City. Candidates should be hard-working, motivated and committed to public service on behalf of the people of the State of New York.

MFCU, the centerpiece of New York's efforts to combat Medicaid provider fraud, is looking for experienced detectives to conduct complex investigations into fraud committed by Medicaid providers and others in the healthcare industry who steal from New York State, those involved in the diversion of prescription narcotics, and to investigate and prosecute abuse and neglect of residents in nursing homes, hospitals, and other residential healthcare facilities.

**The qualifications for this position are: Expert interviewing and interrogation skills; expertise in collection of evidence and executing search and arrest warrants; experience conducting undercover operations involving surveillance; experience investigating narcotics operations, insurance fraud cases, and electronic crimes; established contacts within the law enforcement community serving the greater NYC area.**

### **Qualifications in addition to those listed above:**

The Public Officer's Law requires that police officers at the OAG be citizens of the United States and reside in New York State.

Must have at least ten years of law enforcement and current NYS basic police school certification.

Fluency in Spanish (including conducting interviews) preferred.

Performance of the duties may require frequent, unscheduled work on evenings and weekends and requires 24/7 availability. This position is in the exempt class, and incumbents serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General. The Hire Rate for this position is \$73,153. Appointments in New York City receive an additional \$3,087 location pay.
