The Office of the New York State Attorney General (OAG) is seeking attorneys who are capable of handling significant, complex litigation in the [Sex Offender Management Bureau](#) (SOMB) in New York City, Westchester, and the Mid-Hudson. The Bureau represents the State of New York in state court proceedings related to Mental Hygiene Law Article 10. Cases in the Bureau frequently present questions of the Mental Hygiene Law, criminal law, constitutional law, agency law, and statutory interpretation.

Attorneys handle all phases of litigation, including trials. Excellent lawyering skills, including research, writing, legal advocacy, and legal analysis are required. **Two (2) or more years of post-graduate legal experience is required. Availability for regular travel in New York City and Westchester County is also required.** Prior prosecutorial experience is a plus.

Applicants must reside in (or intend to soon become a resident of) New York State and be admitted to practice law in New York State. In addition, the Public Officers Law requires that OAG attorneys be citizens of the United States. A two (2) year commitment upon being hired is a condition of employment.
