The Office of the Attorney General is seeking qualified candidates for a Detective Investigator position in the Office of Special Investigation Rochester location. Candidates should be hard working, motivated and committed to public service on behalf of the people of the State of New York.

OSI Detectives participate in investigations of the circumstances, facts and conditions connected with incidents covered by the OSI's legislative mandate, using the highest level of independent judgment and discretion to ensure the integrity, thoroughness, and fairness of the investigations.

Detective Investigators work collaboratively in case specific investigative teams with Assistant Attorneys General, analysts and crime scene technicians while demonstrating the highest level of professionalism.

The qualifications for this specific position include: 5 years of experience at the criminal investigator level; experience conducting internal affairs investigations and investigating complex crimes including homicides, assaults and shootings; expert interviewing and interrogation skills; demonstrated success in complex criminal investigations by combining traditional investigative skills with strong interpersonal skills and the ability to work effectively as part of a multi-disciplinary investigative team; developing and utilizing informants; experience executing search warrants; experience testifying in court; fluency in Spanish; having established law enforcement contacts and experience conducting joint operations between local, state and federal agencies.

Qualifications in addition to those listed above:

Must have at least ten years of law enforcement experience and current NYS basic police school certification.

Must possess a valid NYS driver's license and have the ability to drive a motor vehicle.

The Public Officer's Law requires that police officers at the OAG be citizens of the United States and reside in New York State.

Performance of the duties may require frequent, unscheduled work on evenings and weekends and requires 24/7 availability. This position is in the exempt class, and incumbents serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General. The Hire Rate for this position is \$75,348.
