**Anyone bringing homemade or 3D-printed guns will be paid a total of \$25, regardless of how many are turned in.*

How do I bring a gun to the drop off site?

Guns must be UNLOADED and placed in a plastic bag, a paper bag, or a box.

How many firearms can I surrender?

As many as you wish to provide.

Can I turn in more than one homemade or 3-D printed gun?

Yes, but you will only be paid \$25, regardless of how many you turn in.

What if I surrender a gun part or parts, such as a lower receiver?

We will not give you a gift card for gun parts.

Can any member of the public surrender a gun?

Licensed gun dealers, and active or retired law enforcement officers are not eligible for this program.

Do I need any identification to turn in a firearm?

No, this is an Amnesty program, and no questions are asked of the person dropping off the firearm.
