Dear Chief Garey,

We have reviewed your agency's Executive Law § 75(5)(b) referral of complaints involving Police Officer James Rossi from September 2021 to November 2022. Based on our review, we have not made a finding of pattern or practice of misconduct, use of excessive force, or acts of dishonesty by Officer Rossi.

While we did not find a pattern of misconduct, we note that in connection with Admin Case 23-01, Officer Rossi engaged in substantiated inappropriate contact with a complainant/witness in violation of agency policies that resulted in disciplinary charges and a negotiated disciplinary settlement.

We appreciate the cooperation of you and your agency.
