

Investigations Division Organized Crime Task Force (OCTF)– White Plains Detective Investigator Reference No. INV_OCTF_WP_6955_053025

The Office of the Attorney General is seeking qualified candidates for a Detective Investigator position located in White Plains, NY. Candidates should be hard-working, motivated, and committed to public service on behalf of the people of the State of New York.

The role of the OCTF is to conduct complex, long-term investigations into various types of organized criminal activity. The majority of OCTF investigations utilize advanced and specialized investigative techniques such as physical surveillance, court authorized eavesdropping of telephones, businesses, vehicles, and computers, as well as search warrants, which include the use of still and video photography. The nature of the investigations conducted by OCTF includes traditional organized crime - gambling, loan sharking, extortion, and narcotics, among others.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must have at least ten (10) years of prior law enforcement experience.
- Have current NYS basic police academy certification approved by DCJS or the ability to successfully complete all requirements to obtain NYS basic police academy certification.
- Must possess a valid NYS Driver's License with ability to operate a motor vehicle.
- Expertise conducting physical surveillance.
- Experience investigating the following types of cases: narcotics, gun trafficking, fraud, white collar crime, and corruption crimes.
- Experience investigating traditional and non-traditional organized crime activities.
- Experience working undercover or conducting undercover investigations.
- Experience testifying in grand juries and/or trials in state and federal jurisdictions.
- Experience as an affiant on search warrants and eavesdropping warrants and knowledgeable of the criteria required to obtain such.
- Demonstrated progressive assumption of responsibility or initiative leading work groups towards organizational goals or objectives (i.e. served as lead investigator on complex cases or was point of contact to other agencies on task forces etc.).
- Experience working directly with law enforcement/government offices on the local, state and federal levels.
- Excellent computer skills, include the Microsoft Office suite of tools.
- Fluency in a second language.
- Experience working in a law enforcement task force environment.
- Having established contacts within the law enforcement community serving the local office of the OCTF and the surrounding areas.

The annual salary for this position is \$75,348. Appointments in White Plains receive an additional \$4,000 location pay. This position is overtime eligible. Performance of the duties may require frequent, unscheduled work on evenings and weekends and requires 24/7 availability. This position is in the exempt class, and incumbents serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General.

Candidates from diverse backgrounds are encouraged to apply. The OAG is an equal opportunity employer and is committed to workplace diversity.
