The Office of the Attorney General (OAG) is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Deputy Chief Investigator. Candidates should be hard working, motivated and committed to public service on behalf of the people of the State of New York.

## **Minimum Qualifications:**

- At least ten (10) years of law enforcement experience with at least five (5) years of law enforcement supervision experience.
- Current NYS basic police academy certification approved by DCJS or the ability to obtain one.
- Extensive experience in developing training plans for an accredited, large police agency.
- Experience supervising at least 25 subordinates involved in the investigation of various criminal activities, such as financial crimes and insurance fraud.
- Ability to effectively manage multiple investigations in a variety of disciplines.
- Experience with Public Integrity investigations.
- Experience in developing strategies and goals to enhance unit efficiency.
- Experience with personnel related matters including dispute management and employee evaluations.
- Experience with developing unit budgets and fiscal integrity guidelines.
- Interacting with other law enforcement agencies on a Federal, State and Local level.
- Having law enforcement contacts throughout New York State.
- A valid NYS driver's license with ability to operate a motor vehicle.
- The NYS Public Officer's Law requires that all police officers be citizens of the United States of America and reside within the State of New York at the time of appointment.

The annual salary for this position is \$147,986. Appointments in New York City receive an additional \$4,000 location pay. Performance of the duties may require frequent, unscheduled work on evenings and weekends and requires 24/7 availability. This position is in the exempt class, and incumbents serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General.
