The Office of the Attorney General is seeking a highly qualified and dynamic candidate for the position of Detective Investigator for the greater Syracuse, New York region. Candidates should be hard-working, motivated, and committed to public service on behalf of the people of the State of New York.

Detective Investigators, under supervision, conduct detailed investigations of the circumstances, facts and conditions connected with complaints and violations of the law, using the highest level of independent judgment and discretion. These are often highly complex and sensitive criminal matters which cross county lines, involve organized crime and public corruption. Successful candidates will combine traditional investigative skills with current technological skills, coupled with strong interpersonal skills and the ability to work in multi-disciplinary teams to bring cases to completion.

#### **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Must have at least ten (10) years of prior law enforcement experience.
- Have a current NYS basic police academy certification approved by DCJS or the ability to successfully complete all requirements to obtain NYS basic police academy certification.
- Expert interviewing and interrogation skills.
- Extensive experience investigating confidential and sensitive matters.
- Extensive experience in the investigations of fraud and financial crimes.
- Advanced computer skills.
- Training and experience in Dignitary Protection.
- Experience investigating corruption matters.
- Experience conducting surveillance operations.
- Experience in obtaining and executing search warrants.
- Experience interacting and coordinating with other law enforcement agencies.
- Having established law enforcement contacts in the Syracuse and surrounding counties area.
- Must possess a valid NYS Driver's License with ability to operate a motor vehicle.
- The Public Officer's Law requires that police officers at the OAG be citizens of the United States and reside in New York State.

**The annual salary for this position is \$77,608.** This position is overtime eligible. Performance of the duties may require frequent, unscheduled work on evenings and weekends and requires 24/7 availability. This position is in the exempt class, and incumbents serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General.
