Dear Commissioner Tisch,

We have reviewed your agency's referral of Officer Triston Trunk pursuant to Executive Law Section 75(5)(b). Based on our review, we have concluded that Officer Trunk engaged in a pattern of misuse of NYPD's computer systems while at the Criminal Intelligence Section.

Our finding is based on NYPD's investigation of IAB Log 2021-12519 and its determination that, between October 8, 2018, and September 9, 2021, both while on- and off-duty, Officer Triston Trunk used NYPD database systems to conduct approximately 133 inquiries unrelated to Department business of various individuals and their family members. These repeated and unauthorized data inquiries constitute a pattern by Officer Trunk of abusing his authority, specifically his access to confidential information on NYPD computer systems. Although Officer Trunk was disciplined for his violations of NYPD computer use policy, he was not placed in monitoring despite having received at least six CCRB complaints in the last five years, including as recently as April 2025. We therefore recommend that, consistent with NYPD monitoring policy, Officer Trunk be placed in Level I monitoring for one year.

Pursuant to Executive Law § 75(5)(c), please provide a written response within 90 days as to NYPD's response to this recommended action.
