NEW YORK CITY PEOPLE'S HEARING ON THE REPEAL OF THE CLEAN POWER PLAN

The Trump administration will not be holding hearings in New York on the proposed repeal of the Clean Power Plan—the first-ever nationwide limits on greenhouse gas emissions from existing fossil-fuel power plants.

The “**People’s Hearing**” will ensure New Yorkers’ voices are heard on this important measure.
