I am writing to strongly encourage you to approve the sale of the assets of Fidelis Care to Centene Corporation, resulting in the creation of the Mother Cabrini Health Foundation.

In the City of Binghamton, 34% of our residents live below the poverty level. In female headed households with two or more children, a shocking 75% live below the poverty level! Through the new foundation, more than \$150M a year will be made available to local organizations like ours, enabling us to expand our capabilities to provide critical services to needy individuals and families.

Addressing food insecurity and poverty will make a major difference here in the Southern Tier, where one out of seven community members is at risk of going hungry.
