Ahd Almansoob, Detective, of the Office of the New York State Attorney General ("OAG"), Medicaid Fraud Control Unit ("MFCU"), deposes and says, based upon personal knowledge and upon information and belief, the sources of which include an investigation conducted by members of MFCU, conversations with employees of Kirkhaven, interviews with the victim (V.T.), a review of medical records of V.T. obtained from Kirkhaven and Highland Hospital, and my conversations with the defendant, that in the City of Rochester, County of Monroe, State of New York, the defendant, C'VANNA GIBSON, committed the crimes of:

COUNT 1: Endangering the Welfare of an Incompetent or Physically Disabled Person in the First Degree, a class E felony, in violation of § 260.25 of the Penal Law of the State of New York; in that on or about December 11, 2025, at Kirkhaven, a senior living facility, located at 254 Alexander Street, in the City of Rochester, County of Monroe, State of New York, the defendant knowingly acted in a manner likely to be injurious to the physical, mental and moral welfare of a person who was unable to care for himself or herself because of disability, mental disease or defect; and

COUNT 2: Wilful Violation of Health Laws, an unclassified misdemeanor, in violation of § 12-b(2) of the Public Health Law of the State of New York; in that on or about December 11, 2025, at Kirkhaven, a senior living facility, located at 254 Alexander Street, in the City of Rochester, County of Monroe, State of New York, the defendant wilfully violated § 2803-d(7) of the Public Health Law and Title 10 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations § 81.1(a), by committing an act of abuse, neglect, mistreatment or misappropriation of property by engaging in inappropriate physical contact with a patient or resident of a residential health care facility, while such patient or resident was under the supervision of the facility, which harms or is likely to harm the patient or resident.

Inappropriate physical contact includes, but is not limited to, striking, pinching, kicking, shoving, bumping and sexual molestation.

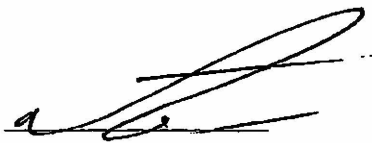
The above-listed crimes were committed as follows:

On or about December 11, 2025, the defendant, C'VANNA GIBSON, was employed at Kirkhaven, a senior living facility, as a Certified Nurse Aide ("CNA"). V.T., whose full name is known to the deponent, was a 79-year-old resident of Kirkhaven who suffered from pleural effusion, a fluid buildup in the lungs, was connected to a feeding tube and was unable to care for himself. He was under the supervision of the facility and being cared for by staff at the time of the incident.

On or about December 11, 2025, at approximately 3:30 am, the defendant, CNA C'VANNA GIBSON, grabbed resident V.T.'s right arm and pushed him into the bed, causing a large skin tear, bleeding, and bruising to V.T.'s right arm. She also grabbed V.T.'s genitals, squeezing and twisting them, and threw liquid in his face.
