Jason Arlington, Shield # 2639, a Detective assigned to the Office of the New York State Attorney General, Medicaid Fraud Control Unit, being duly sworn, deposes and upon information and belief, says as follows:

That on or about July 7, 2026, inside McAuley Residence, a Skilled Nursing Facility, located at 1503 Military Road, in the County of Erie, State of New York, the Defendant, ISIAH FAVORS, committed the offenses of:

Penal Law § 130.30(5) Rape in the Second Degree
D Felony

Penal Law § 260.25 Endangering the Welfare of an Incompetent or Physically Disabled
Person in the First Degree
E felony

IN THAT THE DEFENDANT engaged in oral sexual contact with another person who is incapable of consent by reason of being mentally disabled or mentally incapacitated,

and;

IN THAT THE DEFENDANT knowingly acted in a manner likely to be injurious to the physical, mental, and moral welfare of a person who was unable to care for herself because of a physical disability, mental disease or defect.

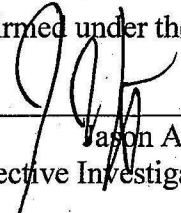
The offenses were committed under the following circumstances:

On or about July 7, 2026, at approximately 12:10 a.m., the defendant ISIAH FAVORS, a certified nurse aide ("CNA") employed by the McAuley Residence ("McAuley"), a skilled nursing facility, engaged in oral sexual contact with 82-year old McAuley resident B.B., whose full name is known to

the Defendant and Complainant and due to medical diagnoses, including dementia and other medical conditions, was incapable of consent by reason of being mentally disabled or mentally incapacitated.

The above allegations of fact are made by the Complainant herein based upon direct knowledge and upon information and belief, with the sources of the Complainant's information and grounds for his belief being the investigation conducted by members of and the files maintained by the Office of the New York State Attorney General, Medicaid Fraud Control Unit and Town of Tonawanda Police Department; records made and maintained in the regular course of business by McAuley regarding its investigation of the above-described incidents and the medical records of B.B., interviews of witnesses known to the Attorney General's Office; a review of internal video surveillance footage maintained by McAuley; and a review of written and oral statements made by the Defendant to McAuley, Town of Tonawanda police officers, and to detectives from the Office of the New York State Attorney General, Medicaid Fraud Control Unit.
