**COUNT 1**

THE GRAND JURY OF QUEENS COUNTY, by this Indictment, accuses the defendants, **JASON ALVAREZ** and **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ** of the crime of **CONSPIRACY IN THE SECOND DEGREE**, in violation of Section 105.15 of the Penal Law of the State of New York, committed as follows:

On or about and between December 9, 2024, and October 30, 2025 in Queens County, Bronx County, Kings County, and elsewhere inside the State of New York, with intent that conduct constituting the crimes of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree, in violation of Section 220.43(1) of the Penal Law of New York, and/or Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Second Degree in violation of Section 220.18(1) of the Penal Law of New York, said crimes being Class A Felonies, be committed, the defendants did knowingly and intentionally agree with each other, and other individuals known to the Grand Jury, to engage in and cause the performance of such conduct as would constitute the above-mentioned Class A Felonies.

## PREAMBLE

It was the purpose of this conspiracy to acquire, possess, and sell cocaine in quantities of at least one-half ounce or more, in Queens County, and elsewhere inside the State of New York.

It was the role of **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ** to possess, prepare, and transport cocaine to **JASON ALVAREZ**.

It was the role of **JASON ALVAREZ** to possess and sell cocaine and to collect the proceeds from selling cocaine to an individual known to the Grand Jury.

It was also part of the conspiracy for members of the conspiracy to communicate with each other and others over cellular telephones using codes and speaking in a guarded, cryptic manner.

## OVERT ACTS

In furtherance of said conspiracy and to achieve the objects thereof, and during the course thereof, the following overt acts, among others, were committed:

1. On or about December 9, 2024, in Queens County, **JASON ALVAREZ**, sold a quantity of cocaine that weighed in excess of two ounces to an individual known to the Grand Jury.
2. On or about January 26, 2025, in Queens County, **JASON ALVAREZ**, sent a text message to **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ**, stating, "Wake up", to which **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ**, replied, via text message, "Getting ready now. . . I'm here".
3. On or about January 26, 2025, in Queens County, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ**, utilizing a black Chevrolet Silverado with Florida Registration PNE8B, provided a quantity of cocaine to **JASON ALVAREZ**.
4. On or about January 26, 2025, in Bronx County, **JASON ALVAREZ**, sold a quantity of cocaine that weighed in excess of two ounces to an individual known to the Grand Jury.

5. On or about February 13, 2025, in Queens County, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ**, utilizing a black Chevrolet Silverado with Florida Registration PNE8B, drove to the residence of **JASON ALVAREZ**, where **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ** handed **JASON ALVAREZ** a white bag, which contained a quantity of cocaine.
6. On or about February 13, 2025, in Queens County, **JASON ALVAREZ**, sold a quantity of cocaine that weighed in excess of two ounces to an individual known to the Grand Jury.
7. On or about March 19, 2025, in Queens County, **JASON ALVAREZ**, sent a series of an outgoing text messages to **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ**, stating, “Yo . . . ETA . . . Waiting”, to which **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ**, replied, in sum and substance, “20 mins . . . Here”.
8. On or about March 19, 2025, in Queens County, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ**, utilizing a black Chevrolet Silverado with Florida Registration PNE8B, provided a quantity of cocaine to **JASON ALVAREZ**.
9. On or about March 19, 2025, in Queens County, **JASON ALVAREZ**, sold a quantity of cocaine that weighed in excess of two ounces to an individual known to the Grand Jury.
10. On or about May 5, 2025, in Queens County, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ**, utilizing a black Chevrolet Silverado with Florida Registration PNE8B, provided a quantity of cocaine to **JASON ALVAREZ**.
11. On or about May 5, 2025, in Queens County, **JASON ALVAREZ**, sold a quantity of cocaine that weighed in excess of two ounces to an individual known to the Grand Jury.
12. On or about June 17, 2025, in Kings County, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ** exited a garage located at 270 Lincoln Avenue, holding a black plastic bag, which he then placed inside of a black Chevrolet Silverado, Florida Registration PNE8B. **CHRISTOPHER**

**SANCHEZ** then drove said vehicle to the residence of **JASON ALVAREZ** in Queens County.

13. On or about June 17, 2025, in Queens County, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ**, utilizing a black Chevrolet Silverado with Florida Registration PNE8B, provided a quantity of cocaine to **JASON ALVAREZ**.
14. On or about June 18, 2025, in Queens County, **JASON ALVAREZ**, sold a quantity of cocaine that weighed in excess of two ounces to an individual known to the Grand Jury.
15. On or about July 30, 2025, in Queens County, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ**, sent an outgoing text message to **JASON ALVAREZ**, stating, in sum and substance, “I’m outside.” to which **JASON ALVAREZ**, replied, in sum and substance, “Okay . . . 2 stops.”
16. On or about July 30, 2025, in Queens County, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ**, utilizing a black Chevrolet Silverado with Florida Registration PNE8B, provided a quantity of cocaine to **JASON ALVAREZ**.
17. On or about July 31, 2025, in Queens County, **JASON ALVAREZ**, sold a quantity of cocaine that weighed in excess of two ounces to an individual known to the Grand Jury.
18. On or about September 23, 2025, in Queens County, **JASON ALVAREZ**, sold a quantity of cocaine that weighed in excess of two ounces to an individual known to the Grand Jury.
19. On or about October 14, 2025, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ** sent an outgoing text message to **JASON ALVAREZ**, stating, in sum and substance, “Tomorrow 9ish”, to which **JASON ALVAREZ** replied “OK.”.
20. On or about October 15, 2025, in Queens County, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ**, utilizing a black Chevrolet Silverado with Florida Registration PNE8B, met with **JASON**

**ALAVREZ**, at which time **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ** handed **JASON ALVAREZ** a black plastic bag containing a quantity of cocaine.

21. On or about October 15, 2025, in Queens County, **JASON ALVAREZ**, sold a black plastic bag containing a quantity of cocaine that weighed in excess of two ounces to an individual known to the Grand Jury.
22. On or about October 30, 2025, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ** sent an outgoing WhatsApp text message to **JASON ALVAREZ** stating, in sum and substance, “25 min bro. Can’t pick up.”
23. On or about October 30, 2025, in Queens County, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ** was in possession of a quantity of cocaine weighing in excess of 8 ounces.
24. On or about October 30, 2025, at 270 Lincoln Avenue in Kings County, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ** was in possession of kilogram presses, scales, and narcotics adulterant.
25. On or about October 30, 2025, in Queens County, **JASON ALVAREZ** was in possession of quantity of cocaine weighing in excess of one-half of an ounce.

## **COUNT 2**

THE GRAND JURY OF QUEENS COUNTY, by this Indictment, accuses the defendant, **JASON ALVAREZ** of the crime of **CRIMINAL SALE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE IN THE FIRST DEGREE**, in violation of Section 220.43(1) of the Penal Law of the State of New York, committed as follows:

Said defendant, on or about December 9, 2024, in Queens County, did knowingly and unlawfully sell one or more preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances containing a narcotic drug, to wit: cocaine, and said preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances were of an aggregate weight of two ounces or more.

**COUNT 3**

THE GRAND JURY OF QUEENS COUNTY, by this Indictment, accuses the defendant, **JASON ALVAREZ** of the crime of **CRIMINAL POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE IN THE THIRD DEGREE**, in violation of Section 220.16(12) of the Penal Law of the State of New York, committed as follows:

Said defendant, on or about October 30, 2025, in Queens County, did knowingly and unlawfully possess one or more preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances containing a narcotic drug, to wit: cocaine, and said preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances were of an aggregate weight of one-half ounce or more.

**COUNT 63**

THE GRAND JURY OF QUEENS COUNTY, by this Indictment, accuses the defendant, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ** of the crime of **UNLAWFUL FLEEING A POLICE OFFICER IN A MOTOR VEHICLE IN THE THIRD DEGREE**, in violation of Section 270.25 of the Penal Law of the State of New York, committed as follows:

Said defendant, on or about October 30, 2025, in Queens County, knowing that said defendant was directed to stop his motor vehicle by a uniformed police officer or a marked police vehicle by the activation of either the lights or the lights and siren of said vehicle, did thereafter attempt to flee such officer or such vehicle by engaging in reckless driving as defined by Section 1212 of the vehicle and traffic law.

**COUNT 64**

THE GRAND JURY OF QUEENS COUNTY, by this Indictment, accuses the defendant, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ** of the crime of **RESISTING ARREST**, in violation of Section 205.30 of the Penal Law of the State of New York, committed as follows:

Said defendant, on or about October 30, 2025, in Queens County, did intentionally prevent or attempt to prevent a police officer or peace officer from effecting an authorized arrest on himself.

**COUNT 65**

THE GRAND JURY OF QUEENS COUNTY, by this Indictment, accuses the defendant, **CHRISTOPHER SANCHEZ** of the crime of **OBSTRUCTING GOVERNMENTAL ADMINISTRATION IN THE SECOND DEGREE**, in violation of Section 195.05(1) of the Penal Law of the State of New York, committed as follows:

Said defendant, on or about October 30, 2025, in Queens County, did intentionally obstruct, impair or pervert the administration of law or other governmental function or prevented or attempted to prevent a public servant from performing an official function, by means of intimidation, physical force or interference, or by means of an independently unlawful act.
