FIRST COUNT

THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF QUEENS BY THIS INDICTMENT,
ACCUSES THE DEFENDANT OF MANSLAUGHTER IN THE SECOND DEGREE COMMITTED
AS FOLLOWS:

THE DEFENDANT, ON OR ABOUT APRIL 26, 2023 IN THE COUNTY OF
QUEENS, RECKLESSLY CAUSED THE DEATH OF KAWAN EDWARDS .

SECOND COUNT

THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF QUEENS BY THIS INDICTMENT,
ACCUSES THE DEFENDANT OF CRIMINALLY NEGLIGENT HOMICIDE COMMITTED AS
FOLLOWS:

THE DEFENDANT, ON OR ABOUT APRIL 26, 2023 IN THE COUNTY OF
QUEENS, WITH CRIMINAL NEGLIGENCE, CAUSED THE DEATH OF KAWAN EDWARDS.

THIRD COUNT

THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF QUEENS BY THIS INDICTMENT,
ACCUSES THE DEFENDANT OF ASSAULT IN THE SECOND DEGREE COMMITTED AS
FOLLOWS:

THE DEFENDANT, ON OR ABOUT APRIL 26, 2023 IN THE COUNTY OF
QUEENS, RECKLESSLY CAUSED SERIOUS PHYSICAL INJURY TO KAWAN EDWARDS, BY
MEANS OF A DANGEROUS INSTRUMENT.

FOURTH COUNT

THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF QUEENS BY THIS INDICTMENT,
ACCUSES THE DEFENDANT OF ASSAULT IN THE THIRD DEGREE COMMITTED AS
FOLLOWS:

THE DEFENDANT, ON OR ABOUT APRIL 26, 2023 IN THE COUNTY OF
QUEENS, RECKLESSLY CAUSED PHYSICAL INJURY TO ANOTHER PERSON.

FIFTH COUNT

THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF QUEENS BY THIS INDICTMENT,
ACCUSES THE DEFENDANT OF CRIMINAL MISCHIEF IN THE FOURTH DEGREE
COMMITTED AS FOLLOWS:

THE DEFENDANT, ON OR ABOUT APRIL 26, 2023 IN THE COUNTY OF
QUEENS, HAVING NO RIGHT TO DO SO NOR ANY REASONABLE GROUND TO BELIEVE
THAT HE HAD SUCH RIGHT, RECKLESSLY DAMAGED PROPERTY OF AN INDIVIDUAL
KNOWN TO THE GRAND JURY, TO WIT: A MOTOR VEHICLE IN AN AMOUNT
EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS.
