FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q. How do I bring a gun to the drop off site?
 - A. Guns must be UNLOADED, and placed in a plastic bag, a paper bag, or a box.
- Q. Can I transport the firearm in a car?
 - A. Yes. It must be UNLOADED and in the trunk in a plastic or paper bag, or a box.
- Q. How many firearms can I surrender?
 - A. As many as you wish to provide.
- Q. Can any member of the public surrender a gun?
 - A. Licensed gun dealers, and active or retired law enforcement officers are not eligible for this program.
- Q. Do I need any identification to turn in a firearm?
 - A. No. This is an Amnesty program and no questions are asked of the person dropping off the firearm.
