From on or before March 4, 2016, through on or about February 17, 2017, in St. Lawrence County, Cortland County, Chenango County, Clinton County, Bronx County, New York County, Essex County and elsewhere in the State of New York and the State of New Jersey, with intent that conduct constituting the crimes of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree, Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Second Degree, and/or Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Second Degree, said crimes being Class A felonies, be committed, the defendants knowingly and intentionally agreed with each other and with others, known and unknown, to engage in and cause the performance of such conduct.

It was also part of this conspiracy MICHAEL LAURI to provide CURTIS FELDER with narcotics for distribution to others.

It was also part of this conspiracy for DEANDRE GATSON to provide narcotics to CHRISTOPHER KOCIENSKI to re-sell to others.

It was also part of this conspiracy for SHAKA WILLIAMS to provide narcotics to CHRISTOPHER KOCIENSKI, JENNA LAMAR, CASEY JO WEST, DANIEL NYE, JASON HENRIQUEZ and TRISTA LADUE for them to distribute to others.

It was also part of this conspiracy for JOSE MARTE to provide narcotics to CIERRA SMITH, CHRISTOPHER KOCIENSKI, ANTHONY BUSHEY, STACEY HALEY, LEAH MUSANTE, KAMAO DOUGLAS, SAMANTHA GRIFFIN and others for distribution to others.

It was also part of this conspiracy for LYDELL WASHINGTON to provide narcotics to KAMAO DOUGLAS for distribution to others.

It was also part of this conspiracy for CHRISTOPHER REED and TASHAWN DUTTON a/k/a TASHAWN PAYTON to provide narcotics to PAUL RADEL, NICOLE DISHAW, and MICHAEL BERRY for distribution to others.

It was also part of this conspiracy for YASIF SIMS, QUAREESE WEST and SABRINA TORREZ to provide narcotics to MICHAEL BERRY for distribution to others.

It was also part of this conspiracy for STACEY HALEY, STEPHANIE SELLERS and SAIDAH ABDULKARIM to transport narcotics.

It was also part of this conspiracy for SIERRA HERBICK to provide a residence from which narcotics could be sold and to recruit resellers to distribute the narcotics.

It was also part of this conspiracy for TRAVIS O'NEILL to provide a residence from which narcotics could be sold.

It was also part of this conspiracy for TRAVIS O'NEILL to sell narcotics to FRANCINE SOKOLOWSKI, CHASE BAXTER, JENNA LAMAR, PAUL RADEL, BOBBIEJO STOWELL, LEAH MUSANTE and others for them to distribute to others.

It was also part of this conspiracy for KAMAO DOUGLAS to sell narcotics to JENNA LAMAR, DOUGLAS MONROE, HEATHER AMERAL, TERRY McGREGOR, ADAM BAXTER and others for them to distribute to others.

- 3. On June 9, 2016, PATIENCE DISSOTTLE sold heroin to a person known to the Grand Jury in the Village of Massena, in St. Lawrence County.
- 4. On June 14, 2016, ALLEN OSHIER sold heroin to a person known to the Grand Jury in the Village of Massena, in St. Lawrence County.
- 5. On June 15, 2016, CHRISTOPHER KOCIENSKI sold heroin to a person known to the Grand Jury in the Village of Massena, in St. Lawrence County.
- 6. On June 20, 2016, CIERA SMITH sold heroin to a person known to the Grand Jury in the Town of Stockholm, in St. Lawrence County.

- 9. On August 16, 2016, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, DONNA LAROSE described to CHRISTOPHER KOCIENSKI a heroin sale DONNA LAROSE had made.
- 10. On August 21, 2016, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, SHAKA WILLIAMS offered to sell both cocaine and heroin to CHRISTOPHER KOCIENSKI.

- 11. On August 24, 2016, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, DANDRE GATSON told CHRISTOPHER KOCIENSKI that DANDRE GATSON had cocaine and heroin for KOCIENSKI.
- 12. On August 27, 2016, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, CHASE BAXTER, SHARON GUSHLAW and PATIENCE DISSOTTLE discussed the possibility of PATIENCE DISSOTTLE selling cocaine for CHASE BAXTER and SHARON GUSHLAW.
- 13. On August 31, 2016, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, MARIANO PATTERSON agreed to sell heroin to JENNA LAMAR.
- 14. On September 1, 2016, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, CAISEY LAMOTTE agreed to provide JENNA LAMAR with \$60 worth of narcotics.
- 15. On September 2, 2016, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, JENNA LAMAR offered narcotics to Joshua Bonno if he would give JENNA LAMAR a ride to obtain narcotics and Joshua Bonno agreed.
- 16. On September 2, 2016, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, SAMANTHA GRIFFIN agreed to sell cocaine to PATIENCE DISSOTTLE.

- 26. On October 12, 2016, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, BOBBIE JO LAROCK described to CHRISTOPHER LAROSE how LAROCK needs to sell narcotics to pay off fines from traffic tickets.

- 36. On November 7, 2016, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, BOBBIE JO STOWELL ordered \$500 worth of narcotics from TRAVIS O'NEILL to sell to another person.

- 37. On November 10, 2016, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, FRANCINE SOKOLOWSKI, CHRISTOPHER LAROSE and CAISEY LAMOTTE discussed narcotics they had sold.
- 38. On November 28, 2016, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, LEAH MUSANTE agreed to sell cocaine to TRAVIS O'NEILL.
- 39. On December 5, 2016, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, CURTIS FELDER directed AHIJAH FOSTER to bring bags in order to package narcotics for distribution to others.
- 40. On December 7, 2016, MICHAEL BERRY, YASIF SIMS, QUAREESE WEST, MATTHEW McGRATH and SABRINA TORREZ possessed Fentanyl, heroin and more than eight ounces of cocaine in the Village of Potsdam, in St. Lawrence County.
- 41. On December 9, 2016, SHAKA WILLIAMS possessed more than one-half ounce of heroin in the Town of Plymouth, in Chenango County.
- 42. On December 12, 2016, MELISSA McCARTHY and LYDELL WASHINGTON possessed Fentanyl and cocaine in the Town of North Hudson, in Essex County.
- 43. On December 14, 2016, JOSE MARTE, ANTHONY BUSHEY and STACEY HALEY possessed one-half ounce or more of the narcotic drug cocaine and one-eighth ounce or more of the narcotic drug heroin in New York County.
- 44. On December 14, 2016, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, CURTIS FELDER ordered narcotics from MICHAEL LAURY to sell to others.
- 45. On December 14, 2016, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation with CURTIS FELDER, MICHAEL LAURY inquired whether CURTIS FELDER was prepared to procure more narcotics to sell from MICHAEL LAURY.

- 46. On January 26, 2017, CURTIS FELDER, SAIDAH ABDULKARIM and STEPHANIE SELLERS possessed more than eight ounces of cocaine in the Village of Massena, in St. Lawrence County.
- 47. On February 3, 2017, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, HEATHER AMAREL attempted to broker a \$500 narcotics deal between CURTIS FELDER and an unknown associate of HEATHER AMAREL.
- 48. On February 7, 2017, JASON PURNELL, CURTIS FELDER and TRAVIS O'NEILL possessed more than four ounces of cocaine in the Village of Massena, in St. Lawrence County.
- 49. On February 10, 2017, during a coded, guarded and cryptic telephone conversation, KIMBERLY CLIFFORD ordered adulterants from MICHAEL BERRY for the purpose of preparing narcotics for sale to others.
