

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF ALBANY, by this indictment, accuses the defendants ROBERT DECKER, a/k/a BOB DALE, SCOTT DRISCOLL, and ROBERT LANGLAIS, of the crime of SCHEME TO DEFRAUD IN THE FIRST DEGREE, in violation of Penal Law § 190.65(1)(b), a class E felony, committed as follows:

The defendants, between on or about May 18, 2018 through on or about October 4, 2019, in the County of Albany, State of New York, and elsewhere, engaged in a scheme constituting a systematic ongoing course of conduct with intent to defraud more than one person or to obtain property from more than one person by false or fraudulent pretenses, representations or promises, and so obtained property with a value in excess of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) from one or more of such persons.

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF ALBANY, by this indictment, accuses the defendants ROBERT DECKER, a/k/a BOB DALE, and SCOTT DRISCOLL of the crime of GRAND LARCENY IN THE SECOND DEGREE, in violation of Penal Law § 155.40(1), a class C felony, committed as follows:

The defendants, between on or about October 12, 2018 through on or about October 1, 2019, in the County of Albany, State of New York, and elsewhere, stole property with a value in excess of three thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) from Alex Shchipkov.

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF ALBANY, by this indictment, accuses the defendants ROBERT DECKER, a/k/a BOB DALE, SCOTT DRISCOLL, and ROBERT LANGLAIS, of the crime of GRAND LARCENY IN THE THIRD DEGREE, in violation of Penal Law § 155.35(1), a class D felony, committed as follows:

The defendants, between on or about May 18, 2018 through on or about April 17, 2019, in the County of Albany, State of New York, and elsewhere, stole property with a value in excess of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) from Janet Beaudoin.

COUNT FOUR

THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF ALBANY, by this indictment, accuses the defendants ROBERT DECKER, a/k/a BOB DALE, and SCOTT DRISCOLL of the crime of GRAND LARCENY IN THE THIRD DEGREE, in violation of Penal Law §.155.35(1), a class D felony, committed as follows:

The defendants, between on or about October 17, 2018 through January 20, 2019, in the County of Albany, State of New York, and elsewhere, stole property with a value in excess of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) from Terry Metcalf.

COUNT FIVE

THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF ALBANY, by this indictment, accuses the defendants ROBERT DECKER, a/k/a BOB DALE, and SCOTT DRISCOLL of the crime of GRAND LARCENY IN THE THIRD DEGREE, in violation of Penal Law § 155.35(1), a class D felony, committed as follows:

The defendants, between on or about October 29, 2018 through on or about February 4, 2019, in the County of Albany, State of New York, and elsewhere, stole property with a value in excess of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) from Cuong Mach.

COUNT SIX

The defendants, between on or about January 15, 2019 through on or about May 17, 2019, in the County of Albany, State of New York, and elsewhere, stole property with a value in excess of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) from Matthew Parisi.

COUNT TEN

THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF ALBANY, by this indictment, accuses the defendants ROBERT DECKER, a/k/a BOB DALE, and SCOTT DRISCOLL of the crime of GRAND LARCENY IN THE THIRD DEGREE, in violation of Penal Law § 155.35(1), a class D felony, committed as follows:

The defendants, between on or about February 23, 2019 through on or about April 18, 2019, in the County of Albany, State of New York, and elsewhere, stole property with a value in excess of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) from Donna Reynolds.

COUNT ELEVEN

THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF ALBANY, by this indictment, accuses the defendants ROBERT DECKER, a/k/a BOB DALE, and SCOTT DRISCOLL of the crime of GRAND LARCENY IN THE THIRD DEGREE, in violation of Penal Law § 155.35(1), a class D felony, committed as follows:

The defendants, between on or about April 2, 2019 through on or about May 18, 2019, in the County of Albany, State of New York, and elsewhere, stole property with a value in excess of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) from Martin Gardner.

COUNT TWELVE

The defendants, on or about October 25, 2018, in the County of Albany, State of New York, and elsewhere, with intent to defraud, including an intent to commit another crime or to aid or conceal the commission thereof, made or caused a false entry in the business records of an enterprise, to wit: a Homestead Funding Corp. 203k draw request.

COUNT SIXTEEN

THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF ALBANY, by this indictment, accuses the defendants SCOTT DRISCOLL and ROBERT LANGLAIS of the crime of FALSIFYING BUSINESS RECORDS IN THE FIRST DEGREE, in violation of Penal Law § 175.10, a class E felony, committed as follows:

The defendants, between on or about November 15, 2018 and November 19, 2018, in the County of Albany, State of New York, and elsewhere, with intent to defraud, including an intent to commit another crime or to aid or conceal the commission thereof, made or caused a false entry in the business records of an enterprise, to wit: a Homestead Funding Corp. 203k draw request and change order.

COUNT SEVENTEEN

THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF ALBANY, by this indictment, accuses the defendants SCOTT DRISCOLL and ROBERT LANGLAIS of the crime of FALSIFYING BUSINESS RECORDS IN THE FIRST DEGREE, in violation of Penal Law § 175.10, a class E felony, committed as follows:

The defendants, on or about February 13, 2019, in the County of Albany, State of New York, and elsewhere, with intent to defraud, including an intent to commit another crime or to aid or conceal the commission thereof, made or caused a false entry in the business records of an enterprise, to wit: a Homestead Funding Corp. 203k draw request.
