

## **Detective Supervisor: Investigations – New York City**

The Office of the Attorney General is seeking qualified candidates for a Detective Supervisor position in the location noted above. Candidates should be hard-working, motivated and committed to public service on behalf of the people of the State of New York.

Detective Supervisors oversee investigations of the circumstances, facts and conditions connected with complaints and violations of the law, using the highest level of independent judgment and discretion to ensure the integrity, thoroughness, and fairness of investigations.

This position is assigned to the Executive Protection Unit. **The qualifications for this specific position include: Must be trained and certified in Dignitary Protection; experience conducting protection operations ensuring the security of high-level officials and other dignitaries; experience in threat assessment, protective intelligence and logistical security planning and travel; experience leading team operations, monitoring locations, and deploying personnel; expertise in firearms; experience evaluating and preserving crime scenes and collecting evidence; experience interviewing witnesses; and experience interacting with local, state and federal law enforcement agencies for the purpose of coordinating protective operations.**

Qualifications in addition to those listed above:

Must have at least ten years of law enforcement experience and current NYS basic police school certification.

Performance of the duties may require frequent, unscheduled work on evenings and weekends.
