MFCU, the centerpiece of New York's efforts to combat Medicaid provider fraud, is looking for experienced investigators to conduct complex investigations into fraud committed by Medicaid providers and others in the healthcare industry who steal from New York State, those involved in the diversion of prescription narcotics, and to investigate and prosecute abuse and neglect of residents in nursing homes, hospitals, and other residential healthcare facilities.

**The qualifications for this position are: experience investigating employees of nursing facilities and the elderly residents of those facilities; experience interviewing suspects resulting in court admissible confessions; experience preparing and executing search warrants; experience qualifying witnesses who provide sworn affidavits; experience providing criminal court testimony as a witness to facts and circumstances; experience working cooperatively on investigations with all levels of law enforcement; experience conducting undercover investigations using conventional and electronic surveillance techniques; certified, with extensive experience in the administration of polygraph examinations; established contacts and liaisons with local, State and Federal agencies in the area served by the Syracuse MFCU office.**
