The Office of the New York State Attorney General has reviewed the Executive Law § 75(5)(b) referral of complaints involving Police Officer Louis Buduson from January 2020 to September 2024. Prior to joining the Irondequoit Police Department, Officer Buduson was employed by the Syracuse Police Department, which is the agency that initiated the referral.

Based on our review, we have not made a finding of a pattern or practice of misconduct, use of excessive force or acts of dishonesty by Officer Buduson.
