**REPLY COMMENTS OF FORTY-NINE
STATE ATTORNEYS GENERAL**

I. Introduction and Background

The undersigned State Attorneys General (“State AGs”) submit these Reply Comments in response to the *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* issued by the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) seeking comment on its proposals to consider changes to numbering rules and administration to further combat illegal robocalls.¹ As the Commission is aware, the State AGs have formed a 51-member
