In reference to the above bid solicitation, the following questions/inquiries were submitted, thus we are providing answers to each question below:

**QUESTION:** I have a question about the delivery date on the invitation to bid. The delivery date should follow the normal 90-120 day delivery following the bid award, to get the maximum discount from the manufacturer. We do not have that # of cars in our inventory and this short delivery date would require that we "find" the cars and buy them from another dealer. This would raise the price we would have to charge for the cars. If the Delivery date could be modified to 90 days after the award, we can supply the vehicles at the lowest price to your office.

**ANSWER:** Delivery of vehicle(s) shall be made within fourteen (14) days after receipt of a purchase order (ARO) or March 22, 2013; whichever occurs first. Bidders do not need to have the total quantity to bid on an Item. The "Estimated Quantity (Qty.) Needed" on the Schedule of Items and Prices page is for bidding purposes only. The OAG reserves the right, at the time of making the award of contract, to increase or decrease the quantity of vehicles to meet the need to replenish our current fleet.
