

VOLUNTEER ATTORNEY PROGRAM

The Attorney General has established a Volunteer Attorney Program (VAP), whereby an attorney may serve as a Assistant Attorney General. Volunteer attorneys will not receive any compensation or benefits from the Department of Law. Candidates who possess professional expertise and accomplishment as well as lawyers seeking experience in the public sector are eligible to apply for the VAP. Each candidate for the VAP must submit a cover letter indicating work location and bureau preference, resume and a writing sample to the Legal Recruitment Bureau.
