SECTION I. There is hereby established a Board of Ethics consisting of three (3) members to be appointed by the Town Board of the Town of Bristol, Ontario County, New York, and who shall serve without compensation and at the pleasure of the Town Board. A majority of such members shall be persons other than officers or employees of the Town of Bristol, Ontario County, New York, but shall include at least one member who is an elected or appointed officer or employee of the Town of Bristol, Ontario County, New York.

SECTION II. The Board of Ethics shall have the powers and duties prescribed by Article Eighteen of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York and shall render advisory opinions to the officers and employees of the Town of Bristol, Ontario County, New York with respect to Article Eighteen of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York and any code of ethics adopted pursuant to such article, under such rules and regulations as the Board of Ethics may prescribe. In addition, the Board of Ethics may make recommendations with respect to the drafting and adoption of a code of ethics or amendments thereto upon request of the Town Board of the Town of Bristol.

SECTION III. This local law shall take effect upon filing as provided in Section Twenty-seven of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York.
