Instructions for Preparing Form C - Uniform Franchise Consent to Service of Process

1. The Uniform Franchise Consent to Service of Process form should accompany each initial or renewal filing. Do not use with amendments.

2. Insert the correct legal name of the franchisor, the type of entity it is (e.g., corporation, limited liability company, etc.), and the state of formation.

3. Check the line for each state in which the Application will be filed.

4. Insert the name and address of the person to whom the Franchise Filing State should provide a copy of any notice, process or pleading served on the state agency.

5. Insert the date of signing.

6. In the signature block, insert the correct legal name of the franchisor, and print or type the name and title of the authorized signer. The authorized signer should sign on the "By:" line.

7. Provide an original signed copy.
